

# November 2024 VOTER GUIDE



**A** **San Francisco Unified School District School Improvement Bond**  
A \$790 million bond for building and facility improvements in the San Francisco Unified School District, focusing on safety upgrades, modernization, and infrastructure enhancements.

**B** **Community Health and Medical Facilities, Street Safety, Public Spaces, and Shelter to Reduce Homelessness Bond**  
A \$390 million bond to improve infrastructure, public spaces, and facilities to enhance community health, street safety, and to address homelessness.

**C** **Inspector General**  
Creates a new, non-elected Inspector General position appointed by the Controller to investigate corruption and misconduct within city government.

**D** **City Commissions and Mayoral Authority**  
Reduces the number of city commissions, capping them at 65 and eliminating those deemed redundant.

**E** **Creating a Task Force to Recommend Changing, Eliminating, or Combining City Commissions**  
Competing with Proposition D, creates a task force to evaluate and recommend changes to city commissions, but without mandating immediate cuts.

**F** **Police Staffing and Deferred Retirement**  
Introduces a program to encourage experienced police officers to delay retirement and continue working in exchange for additional compensation.

**G** **Affordable Housing Opportunity Fund for Seniors, Families, and Persons with Disabilities**  
Creates a new set aside to subsidize rental housing for extremely low-income seniors, families, and persons with disabilities.

**H** **Retirement Benefits for Firefighters**  
Lowers the retirement age for firefighters from 58 to 55 to reduce high rates of cancer in firefighters by lowering the amount of time exposed to carcinogens.

**I** **Retirement Benefits for Nurses and 911 Operators**  
Expands retirement benefits for per diem registered nurses and 911 operators in response to staffing shortages in these critical roles.

**J** **Funding Programs Serving Children, Youth, and Families**  
Increases accountability in youth services funding by requiring evaluations from city departments and the San Francisco Unified School District.

**K** **Permanently Closing the Upper Great Highway to Private Vehicles to Establish a Public Open Recreation Space**  
Permanently closes the Upper Great Highway to private vehicles, converting it into a public recreation space.

**L** **Additional Business Tax on Transportation Network Companies and Autonomous Vehicle Businesses**  
Imposes additional business taxes on ride-hailing companies and autonomous vehicle businesses to fund public transportation.

**M** **Changes to Business Taxes**  
Reforms San Francisco's business taxes by exempting thousands of small businesses from gross receipts taxes and bringing greater equity to the City's tax structure.

**N** **First Responder Student Loan and Training Reimbursement Fund**  
Creates a fund to help first responders pay off student loans or job-related education debt.

**O** **Supporting Reproductive Rights**  
Bolsters abortion protections in San Francisco, ensuring access and support for reproductive healthcare services.
